ORGANISATION AND DAILY LIFE

Children are able to

Play, be active, relax, dream, research, discover new things, get to grips with things, spend time outdoors every day, experiment and research, get support, speak and communicate, paint, design, and use friendly and well-equipped rooms, large gym for activities, school and leisure time, diverse sports field, greenery, meandering and lovingly landscaped grounds with various playground equipment, various working groups, pottery group for parents and children, creative group activities, school social work, recreation, relaxation, rest, climbing complex, football pitch and much more

Annual activities

Open day, flea market, ski camp, family sports day, graduation parties, sports festivals, school trips, daytime activities, project week, neighbourhood activities, e.g. "World Games Day", summer festival, school trip, carnival, autumn festival, children's parties, Christmas crafts, graduation activities for groups, holiday childcare, holiday trips and much more.

Daily routine

- 06:30 am - 07:45 am - morning service
- access via the schoolyard until 07:30 am only at the middle entrance
- classes cancellation of the 1st and 5th /6th class
- afternoon service 11:45 am - 4 pm
- access from 2 pm via the school yard only at the middle entrance
- evening service 4 pm – 5 pm
- lunch after school 12 noon - 2 pm
- homework time between 2pm- 3 pm
- during holidays open between 7am- 4pm
- individual emergency solutions possible

Parental contribution

- day care financed by the city of Dresden
- about 10 % is paid by your parental contribution
- Low-income families get a discount.
- The request is possible at the town hall with the contract.



Collection / non – collection

If children are not collected and parents are not reachable, your child will be handed over to the children's and youth emergency service according to the opening hours.

- A separate contract with the food supplier is required. The food supplier will send you a chip card and a PIN code by post.

Holidays games during vacation

- Compulsory registration by letter from the parents
- Emergency care only with employer confirmation
- Cancellation necessary on the day until 8 am.
- waterproof clothing and plastic bottle
- Possibility to use the Dresden Family Pass in summer

In case of illness

- lease leave sick children at home
- cancel before 8 am - **day care centre, school and lunch**



Prohibition to circulate

- traffic is prohibited throughout the school building



Lost and found

- Lost and found are in the lost and found office.
- Professionals of the institution have access to it.
- An exchange of lost goods takes place during festivals and celebrations.
- Lost and Found Office items are cleared after the certificates have been handed out one day after



Education and participation

- The fee can be requested from the Social Security Office.
- A receipt for expenses is required.
- e. g. holiday trips, holiday packages, lunch



Insurance

- Your child is legally insured with us against accidents.
- in individual cases, you need liability insurance
- no insurance cover for material damage
- no insurance cover for civil liability



Lockers

- two children share a locker
- lockers are mandatory for fire protection.
- sports equipment and school bags are available in the group room.
- the lockers are not private lockers and are free of charge.
- assignment made by your professional



Excursions and multi-day trips

- will be announced separately
- accessibility of guards must be ensured
- Child and Youth Protection Act
- the rules of accommodation and use are valid

Day care centre of the speech therapy school (FSH)

- Day groups, family support, individual case management, crisis intervention, educational counselling and activation of voluntary work are possible.
